To provide comprehensive care and support with quality and warmth to children and adolescents under judicial protection and institutional care, guaranteeing a safe, affectionate and structured environment that favors their physical, emotional, educational, social and spiritual development, promoting the full restoration of their rights, their integral well-being and the construction of dignified and autonomous life projects.

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- **To guarantee** comprehensive care in health, education, nutrition and recreation for children and adolescents in institutional care, promoting their **full and balanced development** in all dimensions of being.
- **Strengthening** emotional bonds, self-esteem and socio-emotional skills through individual and group psychological **support processes**, aimed at building healthy, safe and meaningful relationships.
- **To create** playful, educational and creative spaces that encourage **active participation**, free expression and harmonious coexistence, promoting a family environment based on respect, trust and co-responsibility.

TARGET POPULATION

Children and adolescents between the ages of 0 and 17 who are under court-ordered protection and institutional care due to situations of rights violations such as physical and psychological abuse, sexual abuse, neglect, abandonment, extreme poverty, or social exclusion. This population resides at the Casa Hogar de Belén Foundation and requires a family-like care environment, as well as comprehensive support that guarantees their well-being in the areas of health, education, nutrition, emotional, social, and spiritual development, promoting their protection, recovery, and full development.

MAIN ACTIVITIES

- **Close and affectionate support**: regular visits to the homes, generating meaningful bonds with the children and adolescents through the daily Salesian presence.
- **Educational and training support**: school reinforcement, workshops on values and life skills, with a preventive and Salesian approach.
- **Spiritual animation**: organization of moments of prayer, liturgical celebrations and spaces such as the festive oratory.
- **Recreational activities**: dynamics, games, sports and special celebrations that promote joy, teamwork and confidence.
- **Solidarity campaigns**: managing donations and events to support the project's sustainability and raise awareness in the community.

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Detailed Explanation of the Project

The Casa Hogar de Belén Foundation provides support and protection to children and adolescents who have been victims of serious rights violations, such as physical and psychological abuse, sexual abuse, neglect, abandonment, and situations of social risk. Its mission focuses on guaranteeing the restoration of their rights and offering a safe, loving, and educational environment that contributes to the holistic development of each child and adolescent in its care.

Although the center has a formal capacity to serve 40 children and adolescents, it currently maintains an average of 45 beneficiaries, demonstrating a growing demand and the need to strengthen institutional resources to respond with quality and timeliness. This situation underscores the relevance and urgency of the "Bridges of Hope" project.



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The care model implemented is family-based, structured in five small houses where children and adolescents live together in a warm, familiar, and protective environment. Each space has a significant adult figure who not only ensures their care and well-being but also provides personalized support for their emotional, educational, and social development. This approach fosters the development of stable bonds, strengthens their sense of belonging, and builds healthy relationships, all of which are fundamental for emotional healing and psychosocial development.

The groups are organized according to age, sibling relationships, affinities, and specific needs, allowing for a more harmonious environment and appropriate support at each stage of development. Recognizing the complexity of the life stories and emotional scars these children and adolescents experience, intervention must go beyond isolated actions. Comprehensive and sustained support is required, encompassing biological, cognitive, emotional, social, spiritual, and affective dimensions, enabling the reconstruction of their identity, the strengthening of their self-esteem, and the opening to new perspectives on life.

“Bridges of Hope” project seeks to consolidate and strengthen this process through personalized programs of psychological support, educational guidance, life skills training, spiritual support, and spaces for recreation and emotional development. In this way, it helps each child and adolescent to reframe their story, develop socio-emotional skills, achieve progressive autonomy, and access real opportunities for growth.

Involvement of the Salesian Cooperators as an Apostolate

The participation of the Salesian Cooperators in the “Bridges of Hope” project represents the concrete experience of the Salesian charism in service to the most vulnerable, especially children and adolescents at risk and in situations of neglect, who were and continue to be Don Bosco's favorites. This apostolate embodies the mission of being “good Christians and honest citizens,” putting faith into action through compassionate, close, and committed service.

In keeping with the Preventive System and the Salesian pillars—reason, religion, and loving-kindness—the Salesian Cooperators contribute from their specific identity as consecrated lay people to the heart of the work: **accompanying, educating, and loving with patience and hope**. Their involvement is manifested significantly through:

- **Active presence and close accompaniment**, offering listening, emotional support and affective closeness to children and adolescents, guaranteeing a fraternal, respectful and trusting environment.



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- **Support in educational and training processes** , reinforcing school tasks, promoting positive habits, recreational activities and spaces for integral development in the Oratorian style.
- **Spiritual accompaniment** , through moments of prayer, values formation, catechesis and faith experiences that strengthen the spiritual dimension and the construction of meaning in the lives of children and adolescents.
- **Organization of recreational, cultural and human development activities** , inspired by "da mihi animas" and the Salesian pedagogy of joy.
- **Solidarity management of resources and support networks** , contributing from their community service to channel donations, volunteering and alliances that strengthen the sustainability of the project.
- **Testimony of life and fraternity** , reflecting Salesian spirituality and promoting a climate of respect, kindness and hope that sustains the healing and growth process of children and adolescents.

This apostolic commitment allows the project to transcend material assistance and become a transformative life experience, where children and adolescents find people who believe in them, accompany them in the reconstruction of their history, and help them discover their dignity, value, and potential.

Thus, the action of the Salesian Cooperators becomes **a living expression of Don Bosco's dream** : to offer a home, education, affection and opportunities to those who need it most, sowing seeds of future and hope in every heart.
